***Nigersaurus*, Extreme Dinosaur**

Nigersaurus is a 30-foot-long plant-eating dinosaur that lived 110 million years ago in what is now Niger's Sahara Desert. It was discovered by an expedition lead by Dr. Paul Sereno. *Nigersaurus* lived in a lush, wet environment alongside the predatory dinosaur *Suchomimus*, *Ouranosaurus* and *Lurdusaurus* other plant-eaters, and SuperCroc, a 40-foot-long crocodile. *Nigersaurus* had a delicate skull and an extremely wide mouth with more than 500 teeth especially adapted for browsing plants close to the ground.

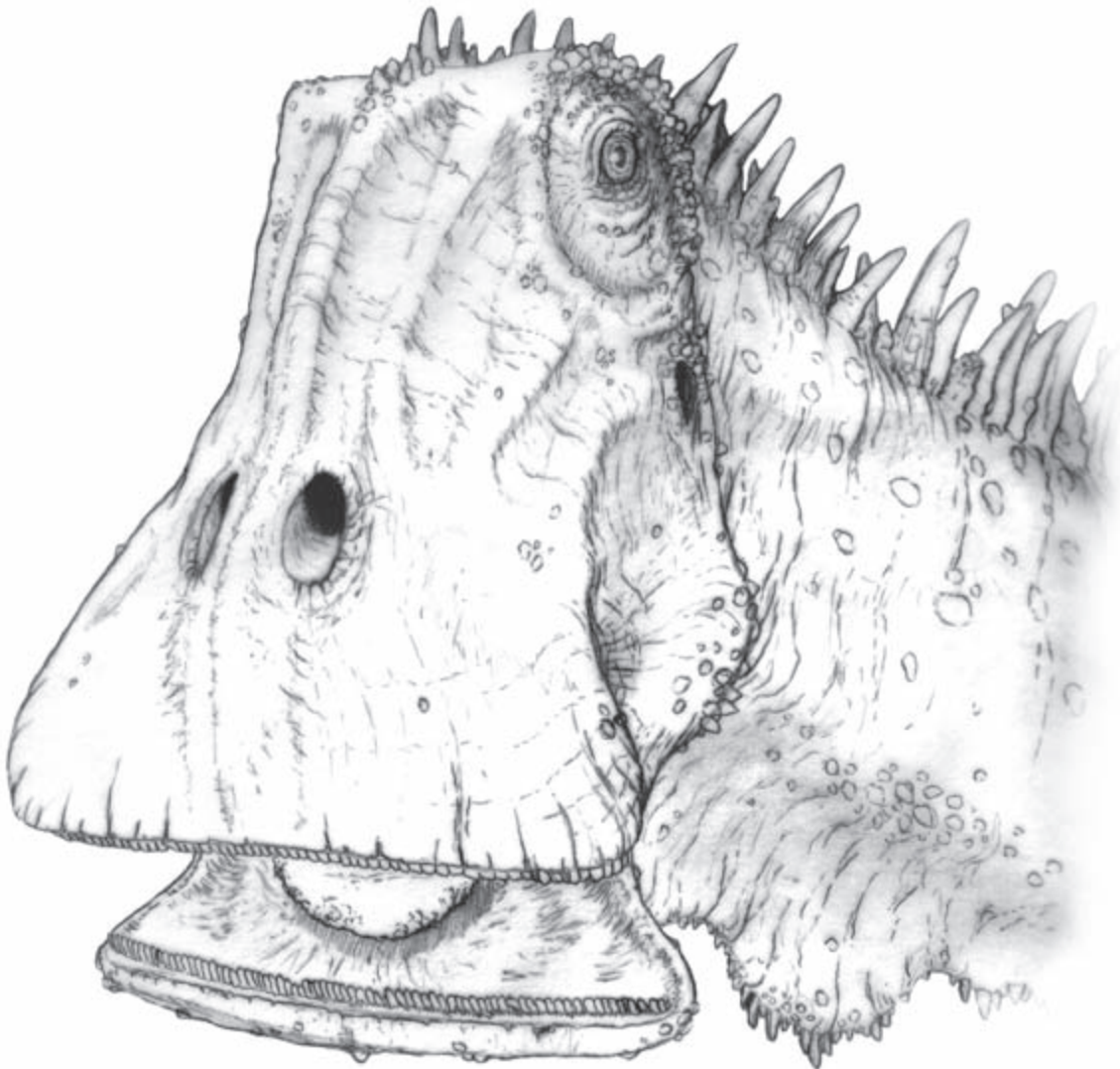
